

BUSINESS BOOTCAMP

It takes place throughout the summer term and provides you with a fundamental grounding in business before you dive deep into end-to-end, global supply chain management.

SUPPLY CHAIN CONSULTING STUDIO

The Supply Chain Consulting Studio combines academic theory with real-world application. During the course, small teams are paired with a corporate sponsor to tackle a real-time, supply chain-related project within their company. Projects reinforce elements of your classroom instruction and results in a keen understanding of both the theory and practice of comprehensive supply chain strategies.











APPLICATION MATERIALS


- + Current resume
- + GMAT or GRE score*
- + TOEFL score (min. 100 international applicants only) or IELTS (min. 7)
- Undergraduate and graduate transcripts; international candidates must submit a WES evaluation
- + Two recommendation forms
- + Essays
- + Nonrefundable application fee
- + An interview may be requested

SCHOLARSHIPS

Ross offers a limited number of merit-based scholarships to exceptional candidates. Interested students must complete the scholarship section of their graduate application. Please note, scholarship responses have no bearing on admissions decisions.

Due to the suspension of in-person GMAT/GRE testing, the GMAT/GRE admissions requirement for the Ross School One-Year Master's Programs are being waived for students applying to begin our programs in Summer/Fall 2021. Please note that the Admissions Committee reserves the right to request test scores if they feel it is necessary to better evaluate an application. Other admissions requirements remain the same.
