Students will complete a total of 57 credit hours, which include a thorough study of business fundamentals, as well as elective courses, allowing you to customize your education to your interests and goals.

COURSES ARE DELIVERED VIA TWO FORMATS

- REAL-TIME CLASS SESSIONS: Live, online sessions with faculty and students include case discussions, group work, role playing, and presentations. A typical 2.25-credit course includes four of these live events.
- + SELF-GUIDED STUDY: Benefit from opportunities to work at your own pace on short modules, readings, and exercises that explain key concepts.
