Program Details

- > The Weekend MBA Program is a two-year, lockstep, cohort model where students are on campus for classes every other weekend. It also includes some distance learning. Students take a set of required core courses and choose from a predetermined set of electives. Classes run from 4-9:10 p.m. on Friday and Saturday from 9:10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- > The Online MBA Program curriculum, delivered through the cutting-edge technology of our digital learning studios, includes live interactive classes, self-quided modules, and three in-person residences. Students take a set of required core courses and can choose from a variety of electives of their choosing. Most students will finish in three to four years.
- > Our Signature MAP course—involving an immersive, real world business challenge—is required in the Weekend and Online programs.
