### **ELECTIVES**

Exchange students can chose to take between 3-5 electives (maximum 2 block week courses) during the exchange term.

### Important Note:

Electives are chosen by students during an 'add/drop' period which is open until shortly before the start of term. Once the deadline for add/drop has passed, no changes can be made to the selection of classes that students have made. There is not a 'taster week' for electives. If a student does not complete a course once it has started, they will fail that course.

### LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

### **English**

All classes are taught and assessed in English - exchange students must be able to write, converse in, and comprehend English. We do not have TOEFL requirement for exchange students. We do however expect our exchange students to be of the same "good standard" as our own MBA students.

TOEFL requirements for our MBA students are: New Internet-based TOEFL Total: min 110 Computer-based TOEFL Total: min 270 Paper-based TOEFL Total: min 637
